

Alfriston College Year 11 Class Selection

Information for 2019 Trimester 2



This document contains all the important information that learners, parents and caregivers should be aware of before selecting their classes.

Instructions for the class selection process

- Each class belongs to a block according to its position in the timetable. There are 5 blocks.
- Learners will take **one class from each block**.
- Learners will be able select a first choice of class from each block and may select an optional second choice of class from each block.
- In the event of the first choice class being full, learners will be placed in their second choice class.
- Most classes are trimester classes (12 weeks)
- Learners would not normally repeat any trimester class that they have already done, however in some classes such as Visual Arts and Performing Arts, it may be possible to remain in the class all year.
- Some classes e.g. the language classes, are full year classes. These are shown in the table below with an asterisk beside the class code.
- Learners cannot normally change out of a full year class during the year, nor opt in to a full year class during the year.
- Learners will be emailed a link to a google form to use for their selections. Learners must be logged in using their Alfriston College logins to access the form.

Learners will be engaged in the profession of Architecture by thinking creatively about social and environmental issues in order to design new forms of architecture. Contexts for learning include creative ideas, analysing local and global historical and contemporary architecture, measurement & scale, axis & geometry, hand sketching, 3d computer modelling and building technologies. This class integrates learning and assessment in the NZ curriculum areas of Digital Technology, English and Maths. Learners will work individually to complete a project that will be assessed for three of the standards in the table.</p> <p>The choice of English standard for individual learners will depend on which English standards they have selected in other classes.</p>

Learners will be engaged in designing a 3D product of their choice that is influenced by research, graphic design practice and drawing skills to develop an idea that is creative. Contexts for learning include authentic applications that learners choose, for example what they design, who their target audience is. Learners will work individually to complete a series of mini-projects that will be assessed against all of the standards on offer in the table. Additional stationery items required for this class are included in the SPD stationary pack that can be ordered through the school. Learners will need to commit to the full year in order to achieve the most from this class because the external assessment does not happen until the end of the year.</p>
