Please be aware of the responsibilities of being a Year 13 Learner...

- Attendance at 90% or above (All Year 13 Learners are required to attend school between the hours of 9.20 and 3.30. Pathway Courses start earlier and finish earlier.)
- Participation in Whānau and co-curricular activities and events including academic, community, cultural and sporting
- Contribution to the school community and the wider community through service, commitment, leadership
- Engagement with a Personalised Learning Pathway Plan to set goals, to explore possibilities, to ensure positive outcomes

A Year 13 Course will consist of:

- 5 school-based subjects and independent learning time, OR
- 3-4 school-based subjects and a Pathway Course (usually 2 days per week)
