Out-of-zone enrolments- 2017

The Alfriston College Board of Trustees has determined that there will be a limited number of Year 9- Year 13 places available for out-of-zone learners in 2017.

This notice indicates how applications are to be made and specifies the date by which all out of zone ballot entries must be received back to Alfriston College.

Ballot entries for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- First Priority: this priority Category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary
- Second Priority: will be given to applicants who are siblings of current learners
- Third Priority: will be given to applicants who are siblings of former learners
- Fourth Priority: will be given to applicants who are children of a former learner of the school
- Fifth Priority: will be given to applicants who are children of board employees
- Sixth Priority: will be given to all other applicants

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
