Uniforms	If renting a uniform you will be invoiced \$150. \$50 of this will be refunded at the end of your stay if the uniform is returned in full and in a reasonable condition. Please note:

- The **administration fee** is payable on enrolment/re-enrolment. It is non-refundable.
- Weekly **homestay fees** **MUST** be paid in advance to Alfriston College. When invoicing homestay fees, we will apply the homestay fee for 7 days before the first day of enrolment through to 7 days after the last day of enrolment. This is necessary as actual arrival and departure dates are often not known at the time of application. Where arrival and departure dates are known, these will be used to invoice. When actual arrival and departure dates differ from those invoiced, an adjustment will be made and any overpayment of homestay fees will be refunded at the end of enrolment. Any underpayment will be met from the student's contingency payment.
- Alfriston College has a **Fee Protection** policy to safeguard the fees paid by International Students, in the unlikely event that the school may not be able to commence or continue to deliver tuition to the International Students. The Schools' Board of Trustees guarantees to hold in reserve sufficient funds to meet the requirements of any refund in these circumstances.
- Medical and travel insurance** is compulsory for the duration of the student's course. It can be arranged through the school with Southern Cross Travel Insurance. Shorter periods (less than 12months) can be arranged. For more information on this policy please view the website www.scti.co.nz/international-student
- Short term tuition** (for 1 term or 1 semester) can be arranged. Please apply to the International Student Leader.

* Please note if you go away there may be a retainer fee to pay for your homestay. This fee is charged during periods when the student is not in the homestay for fourteen days or more and wishes to retain (keep) the room in the homestay. For the first fourteen days absence homestays will be paid five nights at the normal rate and nine nights at \$10 per night
