Please be aware of the responsibilities of being a Year 12 Learner...

- Attendance at 90% or above (All Year 12 Learners are required to attend school between the hours of 9.20 am and 3.30 pm. Pathway Courses start earlier and finish earlier.)
- Participation in Whānau and co-curricular activities and events, including academic, community, cultural and sporting
- Contribution to the school community and the wider community through service, commitment, leadership
- Engagement with a Personalised Learning Pathway Plan - to set goals, to explore possibilities, to ensure positive outcomes

A Year 12 Course will consist of:

- 6 school-based subjects and independent learning time, **OR**
- 4-5 school-based subjects and a **Pathway Course** (1 day per week)

Semesters

- The year is divided into two semesters of 16 weeks.
- Most courses are **2** semesters long. You might change your mind half-way through the year and pick up something new.



The Course Selection Process: WEEKS 7, 8 and 9

STEP 1 **Thursday 5 September: Introduction** from Ms Loomb (THEATRE 9.20)

STEP 2 **Friday 6 September: The New Zealand Curriculum Leaders** will speak about their courses. (THEATRE 9.20)

STEP 3 **Friday 6 September: Course Selection Google Form** circulated to Year 11 by **email**

STEP 4 **Friday 20 September: Year 11 course selections due**
