




## Should I do a PATHWAY COURSE?

## Requirements for PATHWAY COURSES...



#### ATTENDANCE:

- → Compulsory to attend every day, all day, on time
- → Failure to attend leads to removal from the course. (Learners become part-time students.)
- → Communication is crucial

#### **COMPLETION:**

- → Courses will offer resubs and catch-up opportunities
- → Success rates are high for those who complete everything

- 2. You will apply at Pathways by **interview** and completion of an **application pack**.

## ★ University Entrance

is set by universities and involves getting the following:

- Level 3
- **UE Literacy** (5 approved READING credits and 5 approved WRITING credits from a list of Level 3 and Level 2 Achievement Standards which involve those skills.)
- **Numeracy** (10 credits at Level 1 or above from approved standards)
- A total of 14 Achievement Standard credits in at least 3 approved subjects
- And some courses also require additional credits or totals (eg University of Auckland require 17credits in English at Level 2 or 3)

### ★ a Rank Score


- Is an additional total number of credits based on your best 80 credits over 5 subjects
- You are awarded a scale of points for Excellence, Merit and Achieved credits

## **★** Scholarship Exams

- Are optional exams in each subject
