# ATTENDANCE:

- Manurewa Attendance Service in operation
- In Term 1, 88% of all learners attended school more than 70% of school time; 45% of all learners attended school regularly, i.e. more than 90% of school time
- the Asian ethnic group had the highest percentage of students attending regularly, with 62.3% of students attending this often
